CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. §248(j)

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed replacement of the existing 5 MVA transformer with a 7.5 MVA transformer at the Green Mountain Power Corporation Wallingford Substation including upgrading of the existing voltage regulators from 328 Amp to 438 Amp, replacement of the existing breaker and relay, and installation of a security system in Wallingford, Vermont (the "Project") will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Project shall be constructed in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in these proceedings. Any material deviation from these plans must be approved by the Board.
2. Prior to proceeding with construction, GMP shall obtain all necessary permits and approvals. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the proposed project shall be in

accordance with such permits and approvals, and with all other applicable regulations, including those of the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers if required.

3. Other than the commissioning and terminating of the transmission line conductors at the Wallingford Substation, GMP shall restrict construction activities to the hours between 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday, and shall cease construction activities on Sundays and State and Federal Holidays.

4. The Project shall be constructed in accordance with the National Electric Safety Code.

5. This certificate shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
