

Wallingford Recreation Committee

Location of Meeting: Town Hall, School Street, Wallingford, Vermont 05773

Present at Meeting: Diane Baker, Lisa Marchinkowski, and Trisha Nash

The regular meeting of the Recreation Committee of Wallingford was called to order at 7:28 PM on February 4, 2015 at Town Hall by Diane Baker.

I. Approval of Agenda

The agenda for the meeting was distributed and approved by a majority of those present.

II. Review of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved by a majority of those present as amended to include names of those present.

III. Consideration of Open Issues

1. Minutes Approval Last meeting minutes approved with corrections.

2. Summer Recreational Director, Lifeguards/Counselors

There was discussion about the program and personnel. All agreed that we want to move ahead now to recruit the director. We will ask Sandi to advertise the position; the committee discussed the best locations for advertising.

Sandi Switzer can post jobs on Wallingford website. We can advertise at colleges, such as Green Mountain College, CCV, Castleton State and Mount Saint Joseph. We can advertise at Mill River Union High School. Athletic Directors at these colleges can be contacted.

For other personnel, an inquiry can be sent to see whether they plan to return. A notice can be put on website and at Mill River of potential positions for counselor/lifeguard and concession workers.

3. Weeks Of Summer Program

Diane Baker shared dates of last year's program and information that as of meeting, dates for RSSU camp had not been set and that it may run five weeks instead of three.

A discussion ensued about best approach for our local camp; it was decided that we should proceed with same format as last year, with no camp during the three weeks when RSSU camp has traditionally been held.

The weeks of the Wallingford Recreation Summer Program will be

June 22-26, June 29-July 3, July 27-31, August 3-7, and August 10-14.

#### 4. Flyers And Registration Forms

Diane Baker shared last year's forms. There was a discussion of program ideas and expectations for this summer. Many new ideas will be shared with the Director, as well as expectations for programming.

With change in weekly dates, registration form looks good. We will update some of the activities and programs on the flyer.

The Committee plans to advertise during voting; a schedule was set up for committee members to be at the Town Hall to share information and advance registration.

#### 5. Ballfield Vandalism

Lisa Marchinkowski shared that we have the funds to correct vandalism on ballfield, ie. basketball backboards and court itself. In the spring when the snow starts to melt we can investigate the damage and go from there. We would like a specific list of what has been done and what still needs to be corrected to discuss in more detail at our next meeting.

#### 6. Tennis Courts

Lisa Marchinkowski - Question of whether to have a professional organization give us an estimate of what may be needed to fix tennis courts. The Committee agreed that we want it worked on this year, if possible.
