

Wallingford Conservation Commission Minutes*

April 28, 2014

Members in attendance were Carol Macleod, Ralph Nimtz, Debbie Scranton, Marc Pramuk, David Klock and Jillian Bliss. The meeting was held at 6:00 pm at Stone Meadow Recreation Area.

1. Minutes of the March 24, 2014 meeting were approved unanimously.
2. Green Up Day, Saturday, May 3, 2014. Hours are 9am to 11:45 am at the Rotary Building. Ralph will bring a table. Marc will bring a “picture board” to show what WCC does. Carol will bring sign-up/registration sheets, Town tax map, Green-up bags and poster, Face Book information handouts, Wallingford Walks Brochure, Stone Meadow Brochure, and pens. Table will be staffed from 9-10:30 by Carol and Marc and from 10:30-11:45 by Carol and David.
3. USDA Trees – Ralph will pick up trees ordered by us from USDA on Saturday at Rutland Fairground. Pick up is 10AM to 12:30 pm. We ordered 1 bundle of Balsam Fir, 1 bundle of White Cedar, 2 bundles of American Cranberry, 1 bundle of Elderberry and 1 bundle of Red Osier Dogwood. Tree order was paid for in January.
4. Available funds from budget - \$127.15 (Includes donation to WCC by Michael W. Macleod-Ball)
5. We spent most of the meeting walking the trails at Stone Meadow to determine maintenance required. A separate maintenance sheet will be sent to all WCC members separately. Work days were set for Thursday, May 8th at 6PM and Sunday, May 18th from 10AM-12 noon.
