1. Call to order at 6:40 pm. No previous minutes for lack of a quorum last month.
2. Stone Meadow:
 - a. Canoe/Kayak Launch: Grant request was denied. Ralph will investigate simpler approach of grading down to the Creek with stone topping.
 - b. Kiosk Map: Jill offered to take charge of the project to update the map and printing for both kiosks.
 - c. Plowing of parking area: While there is a lot of activity at the Meadow for sliding and hiking, there is no place to park. Request that the Town plow at least swing into or widen the road at that area.
 - d. Dog Park: Since one of the prime activities at the Meadow includes walking dogs, WCC should investigate fencing in an area where dogs could run free and interact with others. Debbie suggested visiting other dog parks like one in Manchester. Perhaps there could be a dog show at the Meadow.
 - e. Fun Day: We will not have a fun day this year because we simply do not have enough members to put it together.
 - f. Gate: Jill has purchased a gate. We will need two, 6x6 pressure treated posts, bags of concrete mix and a lock and chain.

3. Other Business:

- a. Green up Day: WCC will conduct the effort from the Rotary Bldg. as usual. The State effort is underfunded and we may not get the support as before.
- b. Recreation Committee: The WRC happened to be meeting at the same time at the Town Hall. We decided to discuss working together to have enough people to host activities like Fun Day or other educational activities.
- c. Account Balance: \$127.13
