

# Wallingford Recreation Committee Meeting

## Meeting Minutes for 3/11/2015

Meeting called to order at 7:37.

Present: Trish Nash, Diane Baker. Joan Lattuca @ 7:50 and Lisa Marchinkoski @ 8:00.

Last meeting minutes reviewed and approved by Diane and Trisha.

Joan questioned possible extended weeks and location of RSSU camp. Diane and Joan asked that Sandi clarify the dates and location of RSSU camp and any other recreational programs they may have planned.

Trisha motioned that since the Wallingford Elementary School will be unavailable for the recreational program this summer that we inquire about the use of the Town Hall and the library. Discussion followed and motion carried. All in favor.

The Committee reviewed the applications for the Recreational Director. Diane motioned that we interview all applicants for the position. All in favor. A date and time was set up for March 18th starting at 5:30 to interview each applicant. The proposal was made to ask each applicant what they thought of split shifts with the possibility of hiring more than 1 director.

Joan will ask Sandi Switzer to inquire of the select board what rate of pay the Director will have.

Diane shared information about lifeguards and counselors. Our recommendation is to hire all applicants and request that Sandi Switzer schedule them accordingly. The Committee recommends that the 2 concession workers who applied be hired. We will continue to seek applications.

Committee discussed the pavilion. The pavilion recommendation dated June 2014 will be submitted to the select board for approval with recommendation #2 for location - that it be built on the South of the rise in the ground next to the flat spot, before the basketball court hoop, 24' to run east-west. River rocks are suggested for the ground. See recommendations dated June 2014, previously submitted to the board.

Lisa shared that she knew of a company giving yards of dirt away that can be used to level the ground. She will inquire about the details.

Diane shared an information sheet about buoys and new line from Sandi Switzer and that Julie was checking on company where old lines were purchased. Discussion ensued about type of buoys. Committee accepted type on information sheet and will ask that the same lengths of rope and buoy be purchased.

Diane motioned that discussion on recreation field repairs due to past vandalism be tabled until the next meeting. All in favor.
