

Notice of Hearing
On Discontinuing a Portion of Mears Meadow Trail (TH 20)
Town of Wallingford, VT Selectboard

The Selectboard of the Town of Wallingford, VT hereby give notice to the persons named below as owners or persons interested in lands and rights that may be affected by a decision of said Selectboard, acting on a request to discontinue a portion of a town trail.

The request asks that Mears Meadow Trail (TH 20) within the Dean McGee property be discontinued as a town trail. The board and any member of the public will meet at Mears Meadow Trail (TH 20) at the point it enters the Dean McGee property at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 14, 2017 for a site inspection of the trail to be discontinued and then meet at the Wallingford Town Hall, 75 School Street, Wallingford, VT at approximately 7:00 p.m. to conduct a hearing on the question of discontinuing a portion of Mears Meadow Trail (TH 20).

As required by law, notice of this site inspection and hearing is being provided by certified mail to each of persons owning or interested in lands through which the trail passes, listed below, as well as the municipal planning commission. A copy is to be posted at Wallingford Town Hall, and published in the Rutland Herald, a local newspaper of general circulation in the area, not less than 10 days before the time set for the hearing.

The request and other pertinent information relating to the proposed discontinuance are available for public inspection and copying in the office of the Town Administrator of the Town of Wallingford, VT during business hours. A map showing Mears Meadow Trail and the Dean McGee property are also available for review and copying at the town office.
