

Wallingford Selectboard Meeting  
Minutes  
March 4, 2019

Selectboard Members Present: Bill Brooks, Gary Fredette, Rose Regula, Mark Tessier, and Nelson Tift.

Others present: Sandi Switzer.

Chair B. Brooks called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. at Wallingford Elementary School.

**Agenda Amendments.** Trish Nash resignation from the Recreation Committee was added to the Agenda by consensus.

**Minutes.** M. Tessier made a motion that was seconded by R. Regula to approve the 02/18/19 Minutes. Motion carried (5-0). M. Tessier made a motion seconded by R. Regula approving the 08/06/18 Minutes with corrections to Michael McMahon's name. Motion carried (5-0).

**Pay Orders.** N. Tift made a motion that was seconded by M. Tessier approving the pay order total of \$15,842.81 after \$53.25 was added for Initial Ideas. Motion carried (5-0).

**Other Business.** By consensus, the Board accepted Trisha Nash's resignation from the Recreation Committee with appreciation for her service to the community.

R. Regula asked about an update of the Municipal Planning Grant. Town Administrator Sandi Switzer said Rutland Regional Planning Commission's Ed Bove would be meeting with Michelle Kenny on March 5.

S. Switzer asked if any board members had comments regarding Green Mt. National Forest's 15 year plan for habitat creation on 15,000 acres, including White Rocks. G. Fredette said he was in favor of the plan.
