Approval of December 10, 2018 Minutes – Motion made to approve by Bastian and seconded by Michelle

Recreational Director – At the Selectboard meeting it was determined that the Rec. Committee will contribute \$10,000 out of the Rec. monies toward the hire of a Rec. Director to cover salary from May to June and the Selectboard will put in the budget for 2019-2020 \$10,000 for the time period from July-Sept. Bastian will attend a future meeting to find out when the Selectboard will be advertising for the Rec. Director position. In addition advertising for the Lifeguards needs to be put in the paper.

Summer Camp – Plans for 2019. We need to know who is interested in working. Discussion of Life Guards and Jr. Counselors. Perhaps Jr. Counselors would be a reduced rate, maybe training as Life Guards. Age would probably need to be 12 and up.

The Recreation Group will be looking for a Baseball Commissioner In Training. Bastian is willing to share his knowledge and experience with someone willing to step into this role in a couple of seasons.
