

Recreation Committee Meeting  
May 28, 2015

Meeting called to order at 6:36p.m.

Tabled acceptance of 3-18-15 for future meeting

Jenn and Lisa shared ideas for summer rec program. To date, 22 children enrolled. Discussed a need for lawn games and activity supplies. Lisa and Jenn have inventoried and organized materials in the building at the Rec. field. The Gilbert Hart Library will be the indoor drop off/pick up site for the program, as well as the location to use in case of inclement weather. Wendy Savery is currently checking on the possibility of the program being a VT Foodbank drop off site. A welcome letter will be sent out to registered families next week. Sandi will be creating work schedules for lifeguards and camp counselors. She will forward the schedule to Lisa and Jenn. Lisa and Jenn have decided to each work one full day per week and 3 half days. They will collaborate as needed, keeping track of their time with the intention of using some of their before/after program compensation to cover the time

Diane reviewed the budget amounts left to be used by June 30<sup>th</sup>. Maintenance-\$887.50, Lake supplies-\$263.69, Rec. field supplies-\$400. There is a need for a new mop bucket at the lake.

The concession stand at the lake is being painted. A new grill has been donated. There will not be new signs made for the lake due to expense. Sandi is waiting for quotes for the septic tank replacement. Keith Shelvey is hoping to have the new pavilion completed by the June 20<sup>th</sup> lake opening.

Marc Pramuk brought up the idea of coordinating efforts between the rec committee, historical society and the conservation commission to bring positive attention to the town and lake. The idea of dedicating the new pavilion as part of this collaboration will be discussed at a later date.
