

Wallingford Selectboard Meeting
Minutes
March 2, 2020

Selectboard Members Present: Bruce Duchesne, John McClallen, Rose Regula and Nelson Tift. Pat Pranger did not attend.

Others present: Sandi Switzer, Phil Baker and Maria French.

Chair N. Tift called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. at Wallingford Elementary School.

Agenda Amendments. None.

Minutes. R. Regula made a motion that was seconded by J. McClallen to approve the 02/17/20 Minutes. B Duchesne suggested one change. Motion carried with the change (4-0).

R. Regula made a motion that was seconded by B. Duchesne to approve the 02/24/20 Minutes. Motion carried (4-0).

Pay Orders. R. Regula made a motion that was seconded by B. Duchesne to approve the pay order total of \$26,446.91 after \$50 was added for Danby-Mt. Tabor Rod and Gun Club in memory of Robert Underwood and \$900 was added for Rob Barker's tree removal work at Stone Meadow. Motion carried (4-0).

Wallingford Day Tent. Communication/Events Committee Organizer Maria French presented a map of potential tent sites at the ballfield for Wallingford Day in July. She said Green Mt. Tents quoted \$690 for a 20X40 tent including delivery. Funds raised for the event would cover the cost. B. Duchesne noted one of the potential sites on the map was near an underground line. Ms. French said Green Mt. Tents would be responsible for contacting DigSafe. By consensus, the Board approved a \$100 deposit and the tent sites.

Junk Complaints. Board members reviewed property owners' responses to Notices of Violation of the Junk Ordinance with regard to the Weightman property at 59 Meacham Street and the Kennedy property at 250 Railroad Street. By consensus, the Board agreed no further action was necessary for the Weightman property as it was sufficiently addressed. Board members approved Jerome Kennedy's request for an extension to May 1 to clean up the property.

Road Commissioner Report. None.

Public Comments.

Selectboard Concerns. J. McClallen asked under what circumstances the Town enforced ordinances. N. Tift replied when a complaint was filed.

There was a brief conversation about the road crews' salt, sanding and plowing practices.

Other Business. The Board by consensus authorized Town Clerk and Treasurer Julie Sharon to transfer the Energy Committee's CD funds to the general budget to offset the Green Screen Graphics invoice.

R. Regula made a motion that was seconded by J. McClallen to adjourn. Motion carried (4-0).
