

Wallingford Summer Recreation Program Behavior Guidelines and Discipline Procedures

Camp Philosophy: It is our goal to have all campers work and play together respectfully, in a safe, fun environment.

Camp Rules:

Be Kind, Be Respectful, Be Safe

- to staff, others, yourself, and environment,
- stay with the group,
- keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.

Camper Expectations:

- Use of appropriate language.
- Report any difficulties with another child to staff.
- Help clean any area that the group uses.
- Will not interfere with the enjoyment of other campers or members of the public.

When a camper breaks a rule:

- Staff will redirect the camper.
- Time-out may be used to de-escalate the situation.
- The camper will be reminded of behavior guidelines and camp rules and will discuss the situation with staff.
- Staff will document the occurrence and discuss with parents.
- Second occurrence will result in a written warning.
- Third occurrence may result in loss of privilege to attend the program through either a suspension or dismissal from camp.
