Meeting began with Quorum at 6:35

- 1) No changes or adjustments to agenda

- 4) Selectboard Meeting Update: The parade route change to River Street from Railroad St was approved. The Selectboard is still waiting to hear from VTrans for approval for the over-the-street signage. We would like a permanent installation for the Wallingford Day signage for over the road.
