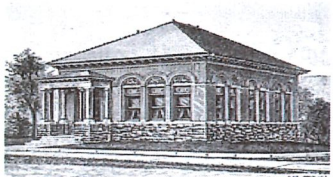

## Selectboard Meeting Highlights

4/01. The Selectboard: 1) appointed K. Luzader as Chair and M. Tessier as Vice Chair; 2) approved Vtrans' Annual Financial Plan; 3) agreed the Town would not buy street signs for private roads (but would install them); 4) heard a report from GMNF reps about acquiring more land, logging operations, etc.; 5) met with Rec Committee reps to discuss roles, budgets and activities (a new procedure by the Selectboard to meet with all Committees annually); 6) approved the Rec Committee applying for a VT Community Foundation grant for repair of the flood damage, the purchase of items for rec activities, and the water project at the rec field; 7) approved extending the dog registration due date to 4/6 as the rabies clinic was delayed due to a snowstorm; 8) appointed/reappointed committee members and extended Rec Committee member terms to 3 years; 9) approved hires and hourly wages for the summer rec program with adjusted hours for the 5-week program along with Elfin Lake personnel; 9) approved the Local Emergency Operational Plan; 10) approved the Public Works Mutual Aid Agreement; 11) discussed the Development Review Board Alternates roles as a result of the DRB questioning alternates participation at hearings (as a town official vs private individual). It was agreed that the DRB should review the municipal and DRB rules, merge where possible; and clearly define alternate procedure language; and 12) approved liquor and tobacco licenses. R. Barker said he's exploring a Shade Tree Preservation Commission to conduct an inventory of trees in rights-of-way and public places and identify sites for future plantings. Approval was given for the Transfer Station to stay an hour longer on one of the Household Hazardous collection days.

4/15. The Selectboard: 1) approved the Grants in Aid letter; 2) discussed Main Street sidewalks; 3) received an update on spring paving; 4) discussed FEMA projects; 5) heard the FY24 third quarter financial report; 6) discussed the Town Hall heat pump project; 7) discussed budgets and mission statements with Conservation and Energy Committee reps; 8) heard an update on the revised zoning regs from E. Berner; 9) approved a letter of support for a Spark Grant for the Green Mountain Neighbors organization; 10) reviewed the Town Hall key list; 11) approved using B. Duchesne for small town maintenance issues that arise; 12) approved R. Barker's request to create a shade tree preservation commission; 13) approved liquor licenses; 14) awarded the ballfield tree removal to Phil Baker & Sons; 15) reviewed the Municipal Roads General Permit progress report; 16) heard an update on the flashing radar signs; 17) approved raising the weekly non resident rate for the summer rec program; 18) approved a new hire for the concession stand; 19) discussed the close out of the ARPA funding reporting requirements; 20) noted the Energy Committee's grant application for solar panels for the town garage was denied; and 21) discussed installing an utility sink for the Town Hall cleaners.

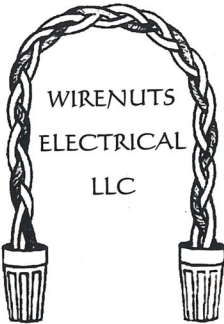
## Animal Regulation Ordinance



**§4204. AT-LARGE PROHIBITED**  
No person shall permit a dog owned by him/her or under his/her control to be at-large as defined in §4203 of this ordinance or to trespass upon the property of another, public or private, except if the dog is on the premises of the dog's owner.

**§4205. REMOVAL OF DOG WASTE REQUIRED**  
The owner, keeper or person in control of any dog shall be responsible for the removal of any defecation deposited by such dog on any private property (other than the owners) within the village (Wallingford Fire District #1) or on all town properties.

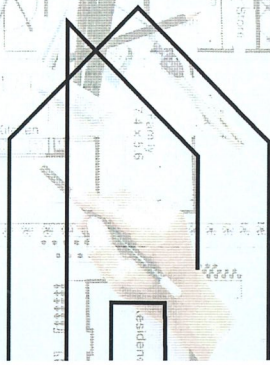
