ON MONDAY, APRIL 15TH  
BY 4:30 P.M.

Please do not delay in paying your property taxes or you will receive an one-time penalty of 8% on top of the standard monthly interest.

You will not receive any bill in the mail for this payment. Please contact us at 802-446-2336 if you need a copy of your property bill. Please remember that postmarked dates are NOT accepted.

You can pay by debit/credit card (3% fee assessed) by selecting "Make a Payment Online" at wallingfordvt.com.

Payment MUST be processed thru Paygov.us by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, April 15th.

### DOG REGISTRATIONS

All dogs, six months of age or older, must be registered annually at the Town Clerk's Office by April 1<sup>st</sup>. A valid rabies certificate must be submitted, and we're happy to issue licenses by mail. \$10 for spayed/neutered; otherwise, it's \$14. A late fee will be assessed after April 1st. ### UNCLAIMED PROPERTY

Unclaimed or "abandoned" property refers to property (stocks, uncashed checks, etc.) or accounts within financial institutions or companies in which there has been no activity generated (or contact with the owner) regarding the property for one year or longer. After a designated period of time with no activity or contact, the property becomes "unclaimed" and by law must be turned over to the state.

Claims for unclaimed property held by the State are processed by the Office of the State Treasurer. There is no charge for this service.

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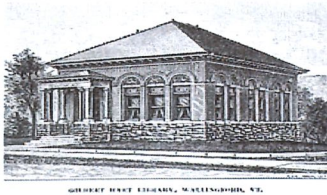

April is National Poetry Month, so expect some poetry out on the book path when the panels are changed. Inside, we have displays of spring themed books to delight most every reader. Beginning early this month, find some resources about the upcoming eclipse as well, although *we do not have viewing glasses!*

We will have copies of the book *Lessons in Chemistry* by Bonnie Garmus, for a book discussion on April 26 at 3:30pm. Reread or read by that date and come out to share your reactions. Another item to check out is the birder's backpack provided by Audubon Vermont. This backpack is designed to support all your backyard, park, marsh, or woodland bird watching with one pair of adult binoculars, bird guides, and general birding info. Go out and explore the sights and sounds of spring, it only comes once a year! This event is open to the public.

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**SOLAR ECLIPSE—MONDAY, APRIL 8TH**

Be prepared to see the greatest sight nature offers, a total eclipse of the Sun. Be sure to get inside the path of totality for the full experience.

Vermont's location within the 2024 total solar eclipse's path of totality makes it a good place to take in the wonder and spectacle of this natural event.

On April 8th at 2:14 p.m., a partial solar eclipse will begin, and at 3:26 p.m., a total eclipse will darken the northern half of Vermont's daytime sky, lasting about 3 minutes. The phenomenon will continue as a partial eclipse until 4:37 p.m. Through Vermont, the speed of the Moon's shadow will accelerate from 2550 miles per hour to 2860 miles per hour.

The Town Clerk's office received a small supply of solar eyeglasses from the Vermont State Department of Tourism and Marketing. Stop in to pick up your free pair.

**Veterans and Property Taxes: What You Should Know**

Don't forget to file your application to receive the 2024 Property Tax Exemption for Disabled Veterans and their Survivors before MAY 1st.

The following are eligible for the exemption: Veterans receiving Disability Compensation at a rating of 50% or higher; Veterans receiving Non-Service Connected Pension aka V.A. Pension or Widower's Pension; or Military retirement pay for a permanent medical military retirement.

The exemption is \$40,000 in Wallingford. The exemption reduces the appraised value of the home prior to the assessment of taxes. The exemption only applies to Primary Residences that are owned by the veteran or survivor.

To receive the exemption, the veteran must provide proof of eligibility to the VT Office of Veterans Affairs every year. Veterans who are determined to be totally and permanently disabled only have to provide proof of eligibility the first year they use the benefit for a home (if they move to a new home in a different town, they will have to provide proof of eligibility again). Proof of eligibility is provided by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Need help? Call the VT Office of Veterans Affairs at 802-828-3379.

### Selectboard Meeting Highlights

**2/27.** The Selectboard: 1) heard a presentation from RRPC's S. Bourque regarding the work being conducted to update the 2018 RRPC Plan for completion by 2026; 2) approved adding Environmental Planner C. Black to the VHB team overseeing the design phase of the School Street sidewalk project; 3) heard an overview of the PC's public hearing on the proposed zoning regulations from E. Berner; 4) approved appointing J. Sharon as Interim ZA for the Wallingford Village Market application, if the request doesn't require DRB review; 5) approved seeking the grader loan refi through the VT Municipal Equipment Loan program; 6) approved the use of Town Hall indefinitely for Wednesday dance classes; 7) approved the tax mapping contract with CAI; 8) approved applying the \$5,000 rebate for the basement weatherization towards the purchase of a new copier; 9) agreed to reorganize at the 4/1; 10) agreed to notify our legislators and bill sponsors of the Board's objection to requiring hybrid meetings for all board/committee meetings held (S.55); 11) set a 4/1 deadline for the road crew to install the flashing radar signs on Routes 7 & 140W; 12) discussed the tree warden's work for W. Hill and Haven Hill Roads; and 13) was notified that the Energy Committee offered their annual budget to replace fluorescent light bulbs with LEDs on Town Hall fixtures.

**3/04.** Road Commissioner P. Baker said the road crew was busy roadside mowing. He discussed the small amount of flood damage done to the Creek Road bridge and Waldo Lane.

The Selectboard: 1) directed Sandi to seek VLCT guidance regarding the question of the role of Development Review Board Alternates; 2) approved Liquor and tobacco licenses for C. Farms, Jiffy Mart, and Midway Oil; 3) approved carrying Sandi's CTO into FY25 as she had to cancel vacation plans because of last summer's flood; 4) discussed dog waste at the rec field and Stone Meadow; 5) discussed inviting committee chairs to future meetings to discuss plans for next year along with budget matters; 6) discussed RRPC's 3/30 event to be held at the library for community input for the regional plan update; and 7) discussed grant close outs and applications.

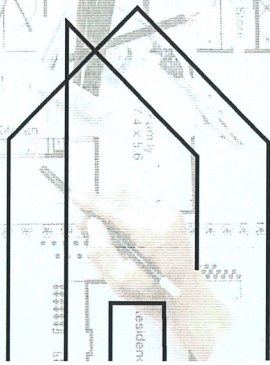
