The Town Hall & Transfer Station will be closed on Monday, September 1st in observance of Labor Day. The first Selectboard meeting in September has been scheduled for Tuesday, September 2nd, at 6:30 p.m.



#### ~Property Tax Bills~

Property tax bills were mailed on August 11th. The first half payment is due by 10/20/25 and the second half payment is due by 4/20/26.

Wallingford's municipal rate was approved by the Selectboard on August 4<sup>th</sup> at \$.4005, down 5 cents, or an 11.25% decrease from the previous fiscal year. The town finished its year end with a surplus of \$137,239. At Town Meeting, the voters approved a general fund operating budget for FY26 of \$1,489,669 with \$1,081,721 to be raised by taxes. The carryover reduced the amount to be raised by taxes to \$943,659.29. The VT Dept. of Taxes set the education tax rate for residents at \$1.6996 and non-residents at \$1.8328.

#### ~Highway Rights-of-Way~

Vermont roadways are laid out to certain specifications. There is a buffer zone on each side of the road that is public. It allows those maintaining the highway to also control vegetation on the roadside. Depending on the location, plant growth can be beneficial or detrimental. Routes 7 and 140 West are maintained by the Vermont Department of Transportation. They have guidelines on tree cutting. All other roads are municipal. Town rights-of-way extend 25 feet from the center of the road. If you have questions about trees near the road where you live, please call me at 802-446-2932.






