

Snowplowing Reminders

Winter Parking Ban is in effect until March 31st. No parking allowed on Wallingford roads between the hours of 11pm and 7am.

It is unlawful to plow snow across a town highway or street in a way that leaves snow in the roadway. Violation of this law may result in a \$100 fine plus the actual cost of repairing any damage resulting from such obstruction of the roadway. (Title 19V.S.A. 1105)

It is unlawful to cause water or ice to run onto a town highway or street in such a way that causes damage to the highway or street, obstructs traffic or creates unsafe conditions. (Title 19 V.S.A. 1111)

The Town of Wallingford is not responsible for vegetation, structures, fences or mailboxes within town highway rights-of-way damaged during snowplowing. (Title 19 V.S.A. 904, 1111)

Watershed United of Vermont awarded a state Dept. of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Design and Implementation Block Grant to the Town of Wallingford for an Elfin Lake Shoreland Restoration Mitigation **Implementation** and Erosion Project. The Town of Wallingford used the \$60,000 grant to hire Fitzgerald Associates as project manager and Mountain View Earthworks to implement designs to maintain the pristine nature of Elfin Lake, which is a hidden gem in central Vermont. Wallingford's project fits well with DEC's goal of supporting efforts to reduce sediment, pollutants, runoff and soil erosion into state rivers, lakes and streams.

Mountain View Earthworks recently completed design implementation to improve stormwater management and reduce sediment and erosion at Elfin Lake public beach in Wallingford, VT. The project included installation of a bioretention basin near the parking area; a stone lined swale to capture runoff; a reconfigured section of beach to be terraced with two bioretention basins and boulder steps leading to the water; revegetation of a portion of the shoreline.





Martha M. Maranville Mystery Solved


