BOUNCY HOUSES ETC

Wally World no longer our vendor for bouncy houses

\$3000 new cost for new vendor: Mountain Bouncers

Mountain Bouncers will provide 20 x 40 hi peak tent, tables and chairs, bouncy houses: obstacle course, slide, paradise, Insurance and generic waiver sent. New waiver of there's needs to be emailed to Selectboard and Sandi

Same issue with standard waiver terminology will need to be addressed by Selectboard (who were going to send prior Wally World waiver to VLCT for comment/advice on standard indemnification terminology)

Sidebar – Discussed replacing the clock for ICE OUT this summer. \$100 or so

Heather gave Erika's note to Naomi and team – wanted to remind everyone that all forms/peddler's permits had to be in before Wallingford Day

Discussed Clifford Green and his cotton candy stand - if he does not do a Peddler permit, he needs to be escorted out. Michael and Todd to be notified if they do not see him first.

All agreed the police officer should have a List of Approved Vendors

Woodfire Pizza - Not available this year. We will book for next year

Concern was mentioned about water supply. Will that be fixed before Wallingford Day?

FIREWORKS

Todd informed us that per his conversation with his insurance company...Per insurance agency, the town has not been covered by C&C Fireworks the past several years. Insurance for fireworks can ONLY be issued for the DAY OF the event. ONLY the Town and affiliates and assigns are insured. Although this means that the person setting off the fireworks, if part of a town committee, would also then be insured, it is best to have them sign a waiver. The person setting off the fireworks, if NOT an employee or affiliate of the town would NOT be insured and would have to sign a waiver.

Todd to pull fire permit off town website and email to insurance company to name Wallingford as insured. Todd has a fireworks vendor. Todd will be setting off fireworks. Todd is part of Wallingford Day committee, under Rec Committee, under town so technically would be indemnified. However, to be extra cautious all agreed he would sign waiver.
